Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission for the Academic Session 2025-26

For Single Major Courses - 40% in aggregate with 45% in the concerned Subject

For Multi Disciplinary Courses - Best Five Marks in H.S./Equivalent course.

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ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission of students commences as soon as the results of the Higher Secondary Examination are declared by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education. Details about the Admission Rules and Regulations can be found at the college website at www.chaipatspbmahavidyalaya.ac.in.

The students are admitted strictly on the basis of merit. The merit is determined as per the following rules prescribed by the University.

Students who pass Higher Secondary or equivalent examination (10+2) with a minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in "Best Five" subjects) or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Major course.

- Students carrying pass marks in at least five subjects are eligible to apply for admission to Multidisciplinary courses.
- Admission is done on a merit basis. The Merit point for admission in the major course is calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the 'Best Five' subjects at higher secondary/equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or a related subject in which the admission in major course is sought.
- Merit point for admission in Multidisciplinary Course is calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best Five' subjects at higher secondary/equivalent examination.
- For admission in Multidisciplinary and Major course, a student must have passed in two language subjects of which one must be English at Higher Secondary/Equivalent examination.
- Any candidate seeking admission in Single Major Courses (ENG, BENG, SANS, HIST) must have obtained 45% marks concerned subjects in Higher Secondary or Equivalent Examination.
- Students passing Higher Secondary Examination from Vocational stream, conducted by W.B.S.C.T&V Education or any other equivalent Board/Council may apply for admission in Multidisciplinary course only.
- Vidyasagar University has introduced the CBSC System for the students B.A. (Hons.) students.

Payment Process : All Payment should be made via online mode only in time of taking admission as prescribed for the concernece course in college website.
